

NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTION CITY OF WILLISTON, FLORIDA

Notice is hereby given that the City of Williston will hold its Municipal Election on Tuesday, April 4, 2023, between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. for the purpose of electing the following:

Group A Councilmember – Two (2) Year Term

Group B Councilmember – Two (2) Year Term

Group C Councilmember – Two (2) Year Term

If a run-off election is necessary, it will be held on Tuesday, May 2, 2023, at the same times.

Candidates seeking election may qualify with the Municipal City Clerk beginning at 12:00 p.m. on Monday, January 23, 2023, and ending at 12:00 p.m. on Friday, January 27, 2023, at the office of the City Clerk located at 50 NW Main Street, Williston, Florida. Qualifying is held during regular office hours, Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. Please contact Latricia Wright, City Clerk, at 352-528-3060 to schedule an appointment, or for additional information.

All persons seeking election shall be a qualified elector and shall be a resident of the City of Williston for a period of one (1) year immediately preceding qualifying. The Mayor and City Councilors are elected on a nonpartisan basis by a city wide vote. The election shall be held in accordance with the Charter of the City of Williston, Florida, and the State of Florida Election Laws.
